We have also continued our professional development focus for teachers on Mathematics, Culturally Responsive Approaches to Education and Inquiry learning. 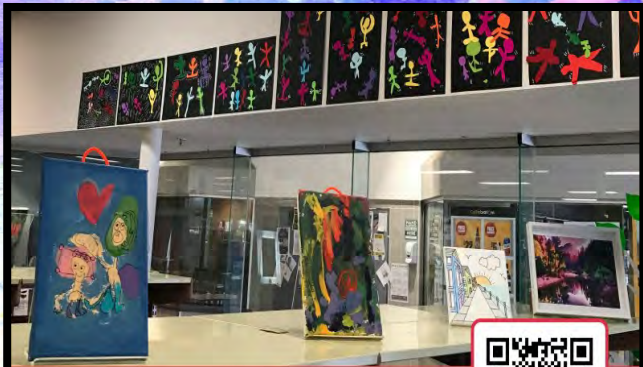

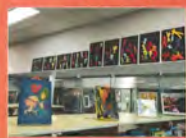
