

Terms and Conditions

1. The Children's Artwork Exhibition is open to children aged one (1) to twelve (12) years old.

2. All artworks must be suitable for an audience of 0 - 12 years.

3. Framed works and works on canvas must be ready to hang using appropriate string or a wire of sufficient strength, length and size to support the weight of the artwork.

4. Each artwork must be clearly labelled on the reverse side with the artist's name and contact details.

5. While due care will be taken, City of Darwin cannot accept liability for any damages caused to artworks for the duration of the exhibition.

6. All artwork must be collected within the timeframe specified. Artworks not collected will be held for up to two (2) months and then will be disposed of.

Choir is by audition only and rehearsals are held after school.


